WISCONSIN'S SUPREME COURT DECISION – SAFER AT HOME

IRON County, WI (May 13, 2020) – Iron County Public Health understands that residents are likely to have questions following the Wisconsin Supreme Court's decision invalidating the Safer At Home Order.

As we wait for additional action from the State of Wisconsin, Iron County Public Health urges residents to continue to practice social distancing and personal hygiene, as recommended by the Centers for Disease Control. Frequent handwashing and cleaning of commonly touched surfaces is strongly recommended at this time, as is wearing a face mask or covering when in close proximity to others when in public.

We continue to encourage local businesses to protect customers and staff by adopting appropriate safety guidelines, such as those offered by the Wisconsin Economic Development Corporation (WEDC).

To assist the public and businesses in adopting these practices, Iron County Public Health has developed brief guidance documents that are available upon request to both businesses and the public.
